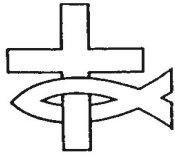

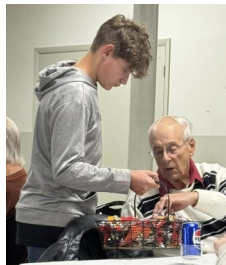

## How to Cook a Turkey
