Amen.

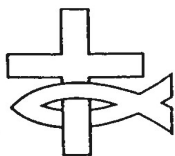

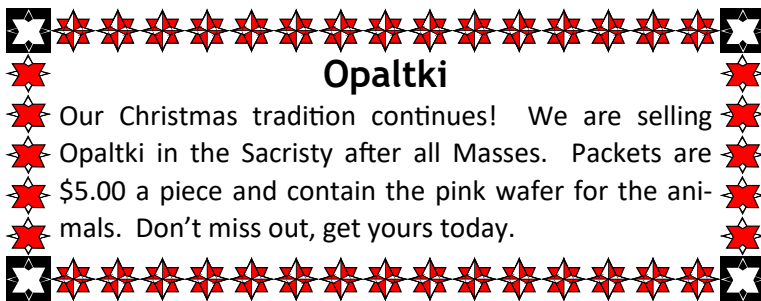
