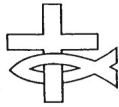

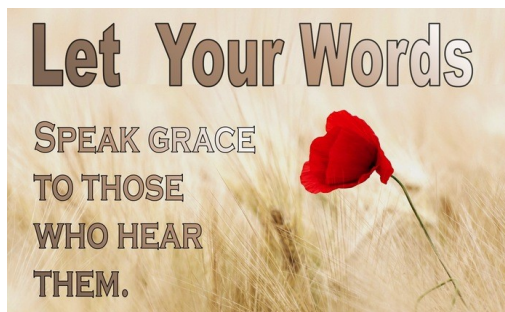


### Rosary Meeting
