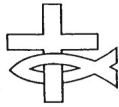

We'd like to share updates about Phase 1 planning activities. Ziolkowski Construction will be on-site the first week of April for pre-construction on the towers, including installing safety tie-off cables, building the support system, and removing one column.

A crane is scheduled for April 9th to remove one column and add temporary support on the Ann Street side. Fabricating the 16 replacement columns is estimated to take 14 weeks. There will be no disruption of masses or services here. Before starting the remaining construction, we must have 2/3 of the necessary funds in the bank by the start date, projected the day after Easter. Please contact our parish volunteers to schedule a meeting to discuss your pledge or answer any questions.

If contacted, please respond to set an appointment; if not yet contacted, use the campaign email or phone listed below to schedule a discussion about your gift. Please don't wait.

It is essential to stay on track to avoid increased costs from extending scaffolding through inactive winter months. Timing is everything, and we need your help and commitment to stay on target.
