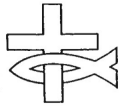

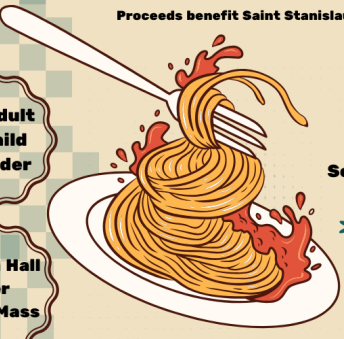

CSA Update

We realize we are in the midst of a major Capital Campaign, but that does not excuse us from participating in the CSA. We rely on the generosity of our Parishioners each year to meet our goal. For as long as Fr. Walter has been here, we have always met our quota! Our goal this year is \$43,566.37 a decrease of \$2,340.63 from 2024. To date we have collected \$12,000, far below our quota. St. John Paul II Monstrance

On November 24, 2004, the late Pope John Paul II blessed six Monstrances for use during the Year of the Eucharist for people to pray for an increase of vocations to ordained ministry and consecrated life. The Year of the Eucharist began October 17, 2005 and concluded in October 2006 with a Synod of Bishops with the Eucharist as its theme. The Monstrances were designated for Eucharistic adoration for vocations for each major continent or geographical area around the world. The six regions are: North America, Latin America, Europe, Asia, Africa, and the Pacific.

The Holy Father presented the North American Continent Monstrance to the US Council of Catholic Bishops for this purpose. In turn, the USCCB gave the Monstrance to Serra with the instruction to fulfill the Pope's request: to ensure that this Monstrance be used in local parishes so that all Catholics far and wide would come together and pray for vocations. Our Parish will have the honor of hosting the monstrance on Sunday, November 8th from 2:00 to 6:00pm.
