



When the U.S. Army Transport Dorchester was struck by a German submarine, Feb. 3, 1943, four Army chaplains spread out among the soldiers, calming the frightened, tending the wounded and guiding the disoriented toward safety. The chaplains represented three faiths: Catholic, Jewish, and Protestant. They selflessly sacrificed their lives to save their fellow soldiers.
