

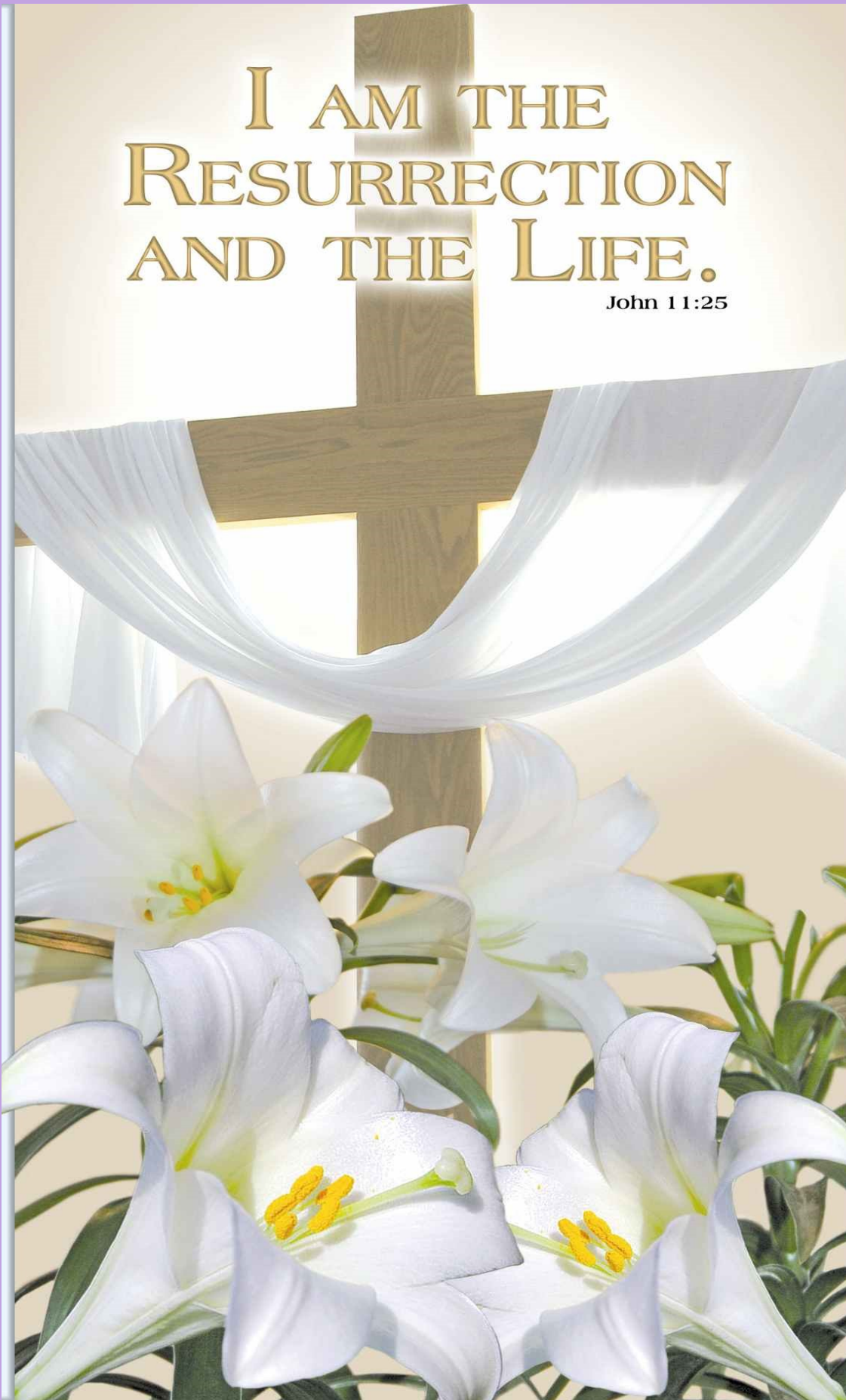

Recently, we were given permission to do the front of our Church between the towers while the scaffold is in place. This resulted in a \$85,000 savings. The project costs \$204,036. With this addition, the front of our building will completely be restored.

To date, the project is approx. 60% complete. We are anticipating Phase I to run through summer of 2026.
