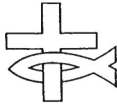

Whether accompanying young people through questions of faith, facilitating small groups, or navigating difficult conversations, ministry leaders are called to create spaces where people feel heard, valued, and invited to encounter Christ. This workshop will explore practical listening skills, effective questioning techniques, and strategies for fostering meaningful dialogue that leads to deeper faith and discipleship. Participants will learn how to move beyond simply giving answers and instead accompany young people and young adults as they discern, grow, and respond to God's call in their lives. **Participants will leave with practical tools to lead conversations that build trust, deepen relationships, and help form missionary disciples.**

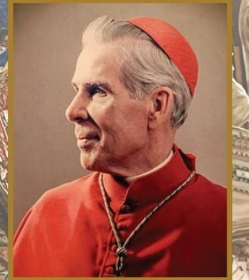
